- · Navigate the health care and social services system
- · Locate a doctor or provider for regular medical care
- · Provide referrals to community supports and services including temporary assistance, housing, SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) and emergency food resources
- Arrange transportation to medical appointments
- Assist in maximizing health benefits (insurance, social security)
- Apply for secure safe and affordable housing
- Seek opportunities for employment
- · Facilitate case conferencing with doctors / providers and care team
- · Help to understand medications
- Understand importance of appointments and reminders
