Jawonio Day Services offers empowering, person-centered support, tailored to individual goals. Emphasizing community involvement through volunteer placements, we provide prevocational opportunities and respite. Operating in convenient locations across Rockland - New City & Nyack and Yonkers.

- Eligibility determined by NYS Office of People with Developmental Disabilities through the Front Door process
- Age 18 or older for OPWDD eligibility
- HCBS Waiver applicable if living with family
- Transportation is provided for eligible participants
